Cost	\$80. This covers food. Of that, \$25 will be given back while there for spending money so all YMs will have the same amount to spend. YMs will be permitted to shop at the PX on Friday after graduation
Gear List	<p>Young Marine ID Card</p> <p>Photocopy of insurance card front and back</p> <p>Cammies – full set with cover, more than one set if they have it (with all patches sewn on)</p> <p>Boots with socks, boot blousers (bring an extra set or two if you can, they are useful)</p> <p>PT Gear –YM Black shorts and red t-shirt (green t-shirt NCOs)</p> <p>White t-shirts – at least 5 (one for each day)</p> <p>White Socks – at least 5 pair</p> <p>Underwear – at least 5 pair</p> <p>Running shoes</p> <p>Nice casual wear – khaki shorts/pants and nice shirt with close toe shoes, belt, etc.</p> <p>Bathing Suit – conservative suit for the ladies, one piece only (females can swim in shorts and a t-shirt if desired)</p> <p>Clothing to sleep in –suggest shorts and a t-shirt</p> <p>Sun screen</p> <p>Insect Repellant</p> <p>Hygiene gear – soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, razors and shaving cream (for the boys who shave), ladies may bring makeup but be aware that it is hot down there and it will melt off your face, you should also pack other necessities as needed)</p> <p>Towels with hand towel, and wash cloth and a beach towel for the pool</p> <p>Shower shoes – flip flops (this is for hygiene reasons, you do not want to walk on that nasty deck in bare feet)</p> <p>Hair pins/Spray for females, hair dryer (if wanted, not required)</p> <p>Small notebook and pens for taking notes</p> <p>Medications are restricted to those that are prescribed and must be checked in with the CO prior to departure. Please note type of medication and frequency to ensure proper usage.</p> <p>YMs may bring portable CD players provided they have headphones, no loud toys (gameboys etc. unless they have headphones, we don't want to make the drivers nuts on the trip). All items of value will be locked in one of the vehicles while we are at Parris Island</p> <p>Watch</p> <p>No jewelry – they will lose it</p> <p>No sharp objects to include buck tools, etc.</p> <p>YMs may bring appropriate reading material for the trip</p> <p>Lockable bag if possible</p> <p>YMs will not need any sleeping gear, we will be sleeping in the barracks and they will provide linen</p>
